Michel Fernex, retired physician, Eminent Profesor from Medical University of Bâle, former member of executive committee of TDR (Special programl for Research on tropical dideases), OMS.

Vassili Nesterenko, deceased in 2008. nuclear physicist, member of the Science academy of Belarus, specialist in radiation safety, founder of the Radiation Safety Institute "BELRAD" (Minsk) managed by his son Alexey since septembre 2008.

Galia Ackerman, journalist, translator of the book "La Supplication", by Svetlana Alexievitch .

Wladimir Tchertkoff, retired journalist retraité from the swiss TV, author of the book "The Crime of Chernobyl - the nuclear goulag" Ed. Actes Sud. 2006, and producer of several movies about Chernobyl.

Following the laws of the Republic of Belarus concerning humanitarian help, the association must have among its members one or more byelorussian citizen(s), in order to facilitate the transfer of the funds raised for prophylaxis and care of th chindren.

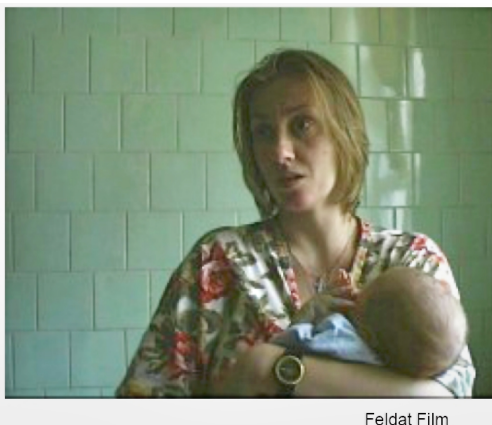
Objectives of the association

Solidarity with children from the contamated zones in Belarus

The radioactive contamination in Belarus comes from the radioactive fallouts of Chernobyl, from April and May 1986. The environmental contamination is the source of the contamination of the organism, due to the ingestion of radiocontaminated food. In the rural sectors, lthe families are too poor to afford to buy radiologically « clean » food.

The radioactive load coming from the food is concentrated in specific organs, irradiating specially internal secretion glands, the pancréas and the heart leading to poorly known sicknesses in young human. One notice a premature aging, an immune deficiency, with a tendency to repetitive and serious infections, high blood pressure, a cardiac deficiency and other symptoms.

The professor Bandazhevsky has proven that a chronical load of 20 becquerels (mesurement unit of radioactivity) of radiocésium (Cs-137) by kg of body weight (Bq/kg) increases the distortions of the children electrocardiogram. A load of 38 Bq/kg and 122 Bq/kg results in a high blood pressure respectively for 26% and 50% ofthe children.

The correlation between dosis and pathology is noticeable in several systems and organs, including the eyes.

And some children show a level of contamination higher than 600 Bq/kg !

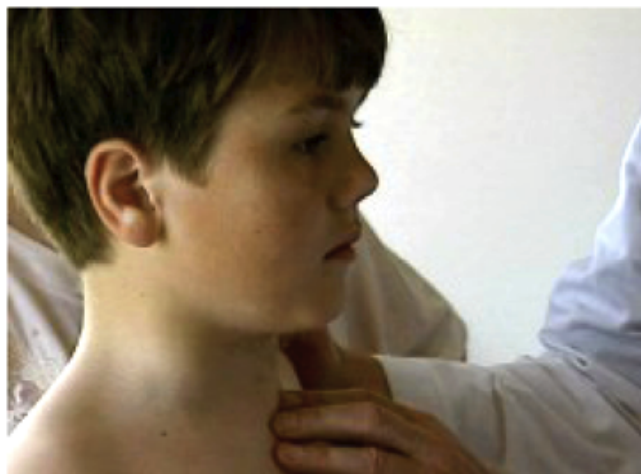

It is possible to help the sick children by sponsoring treatments of apple pectin, a natural adsorbate, which help them to eliminate faster the Césium 137, a radionuclide always present in their everyday food (elimination rate reaches 50, even 70% of the accumulated radioactivity, within three weeks of repeated treatments each quarter).

With the treatments, the radioactivity of the bodies of the children is mesured with a gamma spectrometer used by the teams of the Institute of Radiation Safety "Belrad", and the children are taught the right way of eating, choosing their food, and cooking to minimize their radioactive load.
